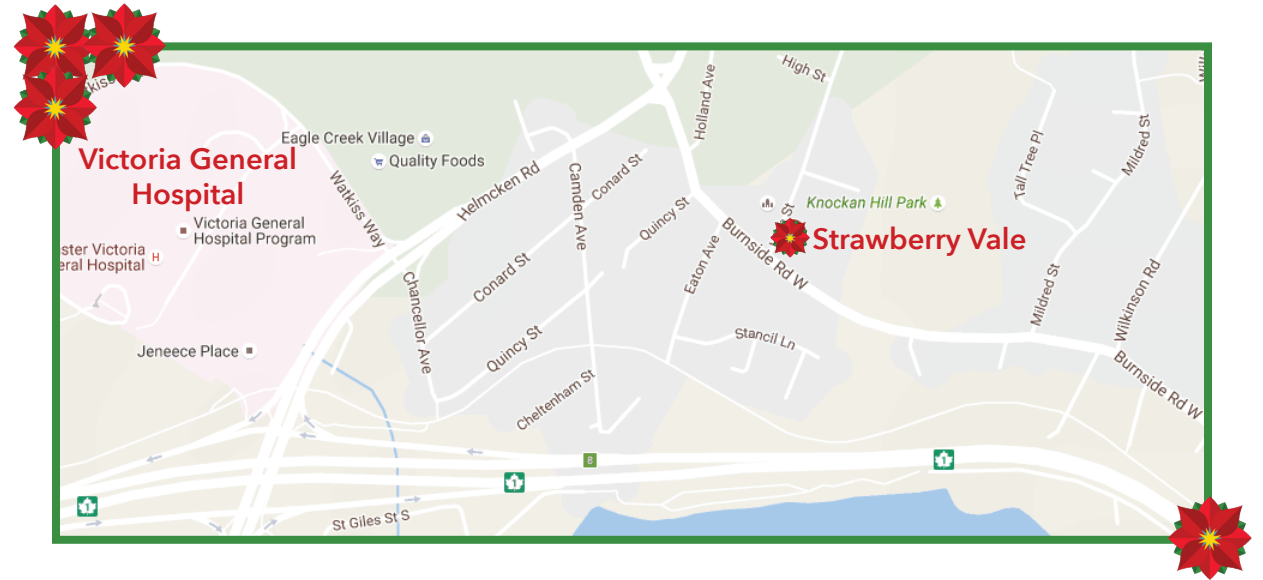

OUR POINSETTIAS

Top Quality: Our plants are of the highest quality and are grown in a separate space in the greenhouse, resulting in large, bushy plants. They take about six months to grow from cuttings.

Safe: Many people worry about poinsettias being poisonous if eaten by their pets or young children. Contrary to popular belief, they are not toxic, although in some cases ingestion of the leaves can cause vomiting or diarrhea. Contact with the sap can cause a rash.

PLANT CARE

Keep your potted poinsettia at normal room temperature in bright filtered light, for example full sunlight filtered through a shade or curtain, and out of drafts. Water only when slightly drooping, the potting mixture should then be thoroughly saturated. Under favourable conditions, the red bracts will remain attractive for two months or longer.
